	Aluminum Cans – help out with this fabulous fundraiser!
	Bread of Life – assist with meals at the Salvation Army (north end) once a month.
	Christian Development Committee – helps plan and promote Christian faith and fellowship; supports and evaluates the congregation’s Christian development; oversees the Social Committee and Education Group.
	Christmas Hampers – assist with food and toy packing in December.
	Church Newsletter – help with folding on the occasional Friday morning.
	Communications Team – become a back-up person to assist with our outdoor sign, website, Facebook page, sound system or Sunday service slide presentation.
	Communion Servers – help serve Communion once or twice a year under the direction of the communion organizer from the Worship Committee.
	Congregational Care – help keep everyone connected by phoning a list of six or eight people about three times a year.
	Counter – be part of a two-person team and help count the collection after the service once every six or seven weeks.
	Crafters – work with a group to make crafts to be sold at the Christmas Bazaar. Group meets the last Friday afternoon of each month.
	Finance Committee – oversees the financial affairs, operations, and budget of the congregation.
	Fund Raising Helper – assist at fund raising events!
	Fund Raising Team – help organize fund raising activities in liaison with the Finance Committee and the Social Committee.
	Gardening – assist with yard clean-up, planting, watering and/or weeding.

	Greeter – welcome people as they arrive at church.
	Green Team – take on a leadership role! Develop, communicate, and implement recycling procedures at Crossroads.
	Growing Souls Youth Worship – assist with nursery care, music, crafts, teaching, or providing nutritious snacks.
	Ministry & Personnel Committee – provides consultation with, support and assessment of all staff persons at Crossroads.
	Odd Job Squad – assist staff with a variety of tasks.
	Outreach Committee – assists the congregation in reaching out to our neighbours locally, nationally and globally.
	Pastoral Care Committee – together with the Minister, addresses the pastoral care needs of the congregation.
	Property Committee – regularly inspects and maintains all properties of the church.
	Scripture Readers – sign up when you can to read scripture for Sunday Services.
	Set-Up and Take-Down Team – help with set-up or take-down of chairs and tables for events.
	Social Committee – help with events by decorating and setting tables; accepting food; setting food out; buying supplies; clearing the tables and/or cleaning up afterwards.
	Sunday Coffee – prepare and serve coffee and tea Sunday mornings after the service.
	Usher – hand out the bulletins for the service and assist with the offering.
	Visioning Committee – work with the Ministers to continue to realize a thriving and dynamic church community.
	Worship Committee – work together with the Minister to oversee the spiritual interests of the congregation.
